WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice Division of the Office of the Governor receives Juvenile Justice Grant funds

WHEREAS, the Commissioner's Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Lamb County that the Juvenile Justice Grant be operated for the 2019 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Lamb County in the State of Texas is qualified to apply for grant funds under the Request for Applications; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner's Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the Commissioner's Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY LAMB COUNTY, TEXAS;

- That the County Judge is authorized to request FY2019 grant funding under the Criminal Justice
 Division of the Office of the Governor for the Juvenile Justice Grant Program and act on behalf of
 the Lamb County in all matters related to the grant application and any subsequent grant
 contract and grant project that may result.
- 2. That if the project is funded, Lamb Count will comply with the grant requirements
- 3. The grant funds and any grant-funded equipment will be used only for the purposes for which they are intended under the grant.
