As per instructions of Section 118.025 LGC, County Clerk's Records Archive, I have prepared a written plan for funding the preservation and restoration of the County Clerk's Record Archives. The 2018 Plan will be placed on the agenda for consideration by the LAMB County Commissioner's Court. A notice of public hearing on the plan was published. After the public hearing, the plan shall be considered for approval by the Commissioners' Court Section 118.025 (i) LGC.

The funds generated from the collection of a fee under this section may be expended only for the preservation and restoration of the county clerk's record archive. The County Clerk shall designate the public documents that are part of the records archive for purposes of this section.

The expenditure of these funds is determined by the amount taken in by this office and projects will be undertaken only when funds are available. The County Clerk will provide the Commissioner's Court with the written quotes and will adhere and comply with Subchapter C, Chapter 262, LGC

Record Management LGC §118.0216

Sec. 118.0216 RECORDS MANAGEMENT AND PRESERVATION. — <u>Each document Filed \$10.00</u> (a) The fee for "Records Management and Preservation" under Section 118.011 is for the records management and preservation services performed by the county clerk after the filing and recording of a document in the records of the office of the clerk. (d) The fee shall be deposited in a separate records archive account in the general fund of the county. Any interest accrued remains with the account. (e) All expenditures from the records management and preservation account shall comply with Subchapter C, Chapter 262.

HB 1513 – Effective September 1, 2013 (expires 9-1-2019) Increased the fee from \$5 to \$10 then in 2019 will revert back to \$5.

Sec 118.025 Each document filed \$10.00 (b) the commissioners court of a county may adopt a records archive fee under Section 118.011(f) as part of the county's annual budget. The fee must be set and itemized in the county's budget as part of the budget preparation process. The fee for "Records Archive" under Section 118.011(f) is for the preservation and restoration services performed by the county clerk in connection with maintaining a county clerk's records archive. (d) The fee shall be deposited in a separate records archive account in the general fund of the county. (e) The funds generated from the collection of a fee under this section may be expended only for the preservation and restoration of the county clerk's records archive. (g) the county clerk shall prepare an annual written plan for funding the preservation and restoration of the county clerk's records archive. All expenditures from the records archive account shall comply with Subchapter C, Chapter 262.

Records Management and Preservation Plan

The overall goal and vision of the County Clerk's office is to:

- Modernize and upgrade old record systems in the office.
- Continue to add records and information to our existing computer system.
- Eliminate or reduce manual lookups and searches.
- Expedite record searching by having more records available for electronic retrieval.
- Preserving original records by reducing daily usage.

COUNTY COURT RECORDS ARCHIVE/MANAGEMENT & PRESERVATION FUND

I. Background (Statutory History)

The 81st Texas Legislature passed SB 1685 that authorized the commissioner's court to adopt a County court records Archive fee of not more than \$5 for the filing of a suite, including an appeal from an inferior court, or a cross-action, counterclaim, intervention, contempt of action, motion for new trial, or third-party petition in a County court in the county. The 83rd Texas Legislature passed HB 1513 that increased the amount to not more than \$10 until September 1, 2019, thereafter the fee is dropped down to no more than \$5.

II. Bill Summary

- *Begins on the approval of County of Lamb 2009-2010 Annual Budget. The fee must be set and itemized in the county's budget as part of the budget preparation process every year.
- *Termination: This fee may be collected until the County court records archive preservation and restoration project is complete.
- *The fee is assessed on the filing of a suit, including an appeal from an inferior court, a cross-action, counterclaim, intervention, contempt action, motion for new trial or third-party petition
- *The fee many only be used to maintain court documents from deterioration and to provide preservation and restoration to older documents in accordance with this plan.

III. Purpose

The purpose of this fee is to off-set the expense in maintaining the older documents filed in the County Clerk's Office. The clerk's office will be imaging the older records to help preserve them. We plan on using the current imaging system to add these older records to our system. This will help preserve older records and enable record searches to be available for electronic retrieval.

Summary

The Legislature has provided a means to raise revenue for the records management and preservation of older county records. This fee is an alternative to spending general fund monies to accomplish these projects. This plan will be implemented in phases as money is accrued and deposited into a special revenue account. Any outsourcing and purchase of equipment will be done through standard purchasing processes. Approval will prevent the potential hazard and "disaster in waiting" as years and years of vital statistics are crumbling, unprotected and adequately preserved.

§ 118.025. County Clerk's Records Archive

- (a) In this section:
- (1) "Deterioration" means any naturally occurring process or a natural disaster that results in the destruction or partial destruction of a public document.
 - (2) "Preservation" means any process that:
- (A) suspends or reduces the deterioration of public documents; or
- (B) provides public access to the public documents in a manner that reduces the risk of deterioration, excluding providing public access to public documents indexed geographically.
- (3) "Public document" means any instrument, document, paper, or other record that the county clerk is authorized to accept for filing or maintaining.
- (4) Repealed by Acts 2005, 79th Leg., ch. 804, § 7.
- (5) "Restoration" means any process that permits the visual enhancement of a public document, including making the document more legible.
- (b) The commissioners court of a county may adopt a records archive fee under Section 118.011(f) as part of the county's annual budget. The fee must be set and itemized in the county's budget as part of the budget preparation process. The fee for "Records Archive" under Section 118.011(f) is for the preservation and restoration services performed by the county clerk in connection with maintaining a county clerk's records archive.
- (c) The fee must be paid at the time a person, excluding a state agency, presents a public document to the county clerk for recording or filing.
- (d) The fee shall be deposited in a separate records archive account in the general fund of the county. Any interest accrued remains with the account.

- (e) The funds generated from the collection of a under this section may be expended only for preservation and restoration of the county cler records archive. The county clerk shall designate public documents that are part of the records archive for purposes of this section. The designation of pudocuments by the county clerk under this subsect is subject to approval by the commissioners court public meeting during the budget process.
- (f) The funds may not be used to purchase, lease develop computer software to geographically in public records, excluding indexing public records lot and block description as provided by Sec. 193,009(b)(4).
- (g) Before collecting the fee under this section county clerk shall prepare an annual written plan funding the preservation and restoration of the couclerk's records archive. The commissioners conshall publish notice of a public hearing on the plan newspaper of general circulation in the county later than the 15th day before the date of the hear After the public hearing, the plan shall be consider for approval by the commissioners court. Funds for the records archive account may be expended only provided by the plan. All expenditures from records archive account shall comply with Subchar C, Chapter 262. The hearing may be held during budget process. After establishing the fee, the process approved annually during the budget process.
- (h) If a county charges a fee under this section notice shall be posted in a conspicuous place in county clerk's office. The notice must state amount of the fee in the following form: "T COMMISSIONERS COURT OF ________ COUNTY HAS DETERMINED THAT A R ORDS ARCHIVE FEE OF \$______ IS NEED TO PRESERVE AND RESTORE COUNTY R ORDS."
- (i) The fee is subject to approval by the commissioners court in a public meeting during the bud process.
