The Lamb County Soil & Water Conservation District (SWCD) was established on August 12, 1946 with the assistance of the Lamb County Commissioners Court. We would like to thank you for your partnership and previous contributions which have helped us conserve Lamb County's natural resources. The Lamb County SWCD works in conjunction with the Texas State Soil & Water Conservation Board (TSSWCB) and The Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) to promote resource conserving agricultural sustainability in our area, through the use of financial programs and/or technical assistance.

In 2019, Lamb County SWCD assisted NRCS with the obligation and administration of 43, EQIP and CSP contracts for approximately \$2,613,860 on about 40,000 acres in Lamb County. Some of the practices included in these contracts are grass planting, drip irrigation, center pivot replacement and conversions, well decommissioning, irrigation pipeline, dairy waste water treatment, and terraces. The district also helped provide technical assistance to hundreds of landowners on thousands more acres.

In 2019, Lamb County SWCD assisted the TSSWCB with the obligation and administration of six State Senate Bill 503 Water Quality contracts for \$41,325.63 on 2655.1 acres in Lamb County. Some of the practices included in these contracts were a solar pump, range planting, a watering facility, fencing, and pipeline.

The Lamb County Soil & Water Conservation District would like for the commissioners to consider a \$3000.00 donation to our district as you have generously done in the past. Your donation would be used to ensure that we can continue to help our local producers conserve our natural resources for future generations.
