
Now on this 13th day of December, 2021, came on to be heard the application of EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY, L.L.C., a corporation duly incorporated, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, for the right and privilege to lay down, construct, operate and maintain pipe lines for the transportation of gas, water and oil, and in connection therewith, power and telephone lines and appurtenances thereto across, on, along, in and under the roads and highways and the streets and alleys of unincorporated cities and towns and other public ground of Lamb County, Texas.

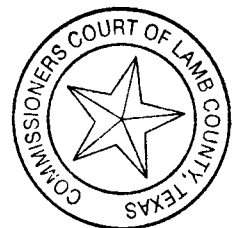
And the County having fully considered the same, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the said El Paso Natural Gas Company, L.L.C., its successor and assigns, or either of them shall be and have, and are hereby granted the right and privilege to lay down, construct, operate and maintain pipe lines for the transportation of gas, water and/or oil, and in connection therewith power and telephone lines and appurtenances thereto across, on, along, in and under the public roads and highways over which the Commissioners' Court has control or jurisdiction, and the streets and alleys of unincorporated cities and towns and other public ground of Lamb County, Texas, with the right to repair, discontinue and remove the same, in whole or in part, at any time, and with all suitable and necessary right of ingress and egress, under the supervision of the County Engineer.


It is further provided that in the construction and maintenance of said pipe lines and pole lines or the removal thereof, the said El Paso Natural Gas Company, L.L.C., its successors and/or assigns shall at all times be subject to such reasonable rules and regulations as may be now or hereafter established by the Commissioners' Court of Lamb County, Texas, and it is further provided that where pipe lines for the transportation of gas, water and/or oil as stated above shall run along or across said roads and/or highways they shall be buried at a depth of at least forty eight inches below the surface of borrow ditches and/or highways, and said company shall restore said roads and highways thus intersected or touched to their former state, or to such state as not to impair their usefulness and shall keep its pipe lines and pole lines in such repair so as not to obstruct or interfere with travel along said road and highways.

El Paso Natural Gas Company, L.L.C., its successors and assigns, shall hold Lamb County, Texas and its officials free and clear of any and all liability for any damage or injury which may result from construction, maintenance, or operation of its pipe lines and pole lines, and the appurtenances thereto.






