**MOTION TO SET TAX RATE:**

"I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of 0.7943, which is effectively a 6.79 percent increase in the tax rate."

*Tex. Tax Code § 26.05(b)(1)*

**(1) include in the ordinance, resolution, or order in type larger than the type used in any other portion of the document:**

(A) the following statement: "THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.";

and

(B) if the tax rate exceeds the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate, the following statement:

"THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 5.92 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$59.20."

and

(2) include on the home page of the Internet website of the taxing unit:

(A) the following statement:

"LAMB COUNTY ADOPTED A TAX RATE THAT WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE"; and

(B) if the tax rate exceeds the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate, the following statement:

"THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 6.79 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$67.90."
