- (B) if the tax rate exceeds the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate, the following statement:

"THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 5.92 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$59.20."

and

- (2) include on the home page of the Internet website of the taxing unit:
- (A) the following statement: "LAMB COUNTY ADOPTED A TAX RATE THAT WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR 'S TAX RATE"; and
- (B) if the tax rate exceeds the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate, the following statement:

"THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 6.79 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$67.90."
