A RESOLUTION OF THE LAMB COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT TO APPROVE THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (TDEM) AND THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) TO PURCHASE AN EMERGENCY GENERATOR FOR LAMB COUNTY.

Whereas, the Texas Division of Emergency Management, Hazard Mitigation Section provides grant funds for Emergency Generators, to allow the entities to purchase equipment that is consistent with approved Hazard Mitigation Plans and

Whereas, these funds are available to Lamb County, through the DR-4705-TX, Texas Severe Winter Storm Hazard Mitigation Grant Program; and

Whereas, Lamb County agrees that the grant funds if awarded to Lamb County will only be used for the purpose for which they are provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. Lamb County Commissioners Court approves and supports the application to apply for these funds in the amount of \$50,000.00; and
- 2. That the Lamb County Judge be authorized to execute any and all documents as administratively required by the Texas Division of Emergency Management in the application and contract process.
