Future agenda items;


Brian Allcorn presented a design for a Lamb County Flag.
Future agenda items were discussed.

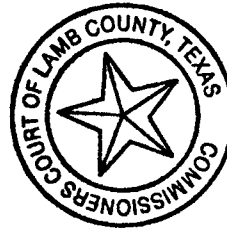
ORDER NO.11:
