**WHEREAS,** the Commissioners Court of Lamb County, Texas, has requested that the Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) permit the installation and operation of automated license plate recognition cameras on US 84 at county line north bound; Hall Avenue and E. 28th Street north bound; US Highway 385 and CR 282 south bound; US Highway 385 and CR 282 north bound; US 84 and McCarty Street east bound; Hall Avenue and E. 28th Street south bound; and

**WHEREAS,** the Commissioners Court of Lamb County, Texas, authorizes the execution of a Multiple Use Agreement with TXDOT for the purposes provided above; and

**WHEREAS,** the Commissioners Court of Lamb County, Texas, finds it to be in the public interest to authorize the County Judge of Lamb County, or his designee, to sign the document referenced above.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF LAMB COUNTY, TEXAS:**


north bound; US 84 and McCarty Street east bound; Hall Avenue and E. 28th Street

1. ALL CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE AND LOCAL AGENCY SPECIFICATIONS UNLESS SPECIFICALLY STATED OR SHOWN OTHERWISE HEREIN.
2. ALL WORK SHALL CONFORM TO ALL APPLICABLE ELECTRICAL CODES EXCEPT WHEN STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND LOCAL AGENCY STANDARDS SUPERSEDE.
3. CONTRACTOR SHALL ENSURE ALL PROPOSED EQUIPMENT INSTALLED IS IN ACCORDANCE WITH NECO REQUIREMENTS AND CLEARANCES.
4. 20. IF THE PROPOSED CANNOT BE INSTALLED PER THE APPROVED PERMITTED PLAN AND BY GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS, A REVISED PLAN MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL, PRIOR TO THE INSTALLATION OF PRODUCTS OR MATERIALS AT THE GIVEN LOCATION WHERE CONFLICTS OCCUR.
21. CONTRACTOR SHALL RESTORE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO EQUAL OR BETTER CONDITION UPON COMPLETION OF WORK AND TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND LOCAL AGENCY AT NO ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION.
22. ANY SIDEWALK AND/OR DRIVEWAY WILL BE REPLACED BY SECTION WITHIN 12 HOURS TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION STANDARDS.
23. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PERMITTEE TO REMAIN ANY DAMAGE TO GENERAL FACILITIES AND/OR PRIVATE PROPERTY CAUSED BY CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT.
24. ALL EXISTING UTILITIES, CROSSING GUTTERS AND STORMWATER COLLECTORS WILL BE KEPT FREE OF MUD AND OTHER DEBRIS AT ALL TIMES DURING CONSTRUCTION.
25. NO STOPPING, STORING OR SEMI-PERMANENT USE OF THE RIGHT OF WAY IS AUTHORIZED UNLESS SPECIFICALLY IDENTIFIED WITHIN THE PERMIT.
26. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL HAVE AN AUTHORIZED PERSON AVAILABLE AT OR NEAR THE WORK SITE TO ADDRESS EMERGENCY ISSUES ASSOCIATED WITH THE PROJECT.
27. AOA COMPLIANCE NOTICE

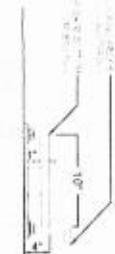
